Poster Preparation	
Format	Portrait
Size	The poster board size at the conference venue is A0 (119 x 85 centimeters). Poster size should not exceed these values
Location/Room	Room C
	Posters can be viewed during the coffee breaks, lunch, and the afternoon coffee break
	Each poster presenter is expected to be in attendance for discussion of their poster at two of the designated times above on the day their poster is being showcased. (Exact time and date will be announced to the presenting authors before the 10th of October, 2017)
Optional	Authors who wish their poster to be also viewed in the screens (smart TVs in the conference hall) during the entire conference (2-4/11/2017), are kindly invited to send their posters in a digital format (1 slide/power point- ppt. or pptx.) to the conference email (info@euripaforum2017.eu). In these cases, it is recommended to reform your digital poster (ONLY) from portrait to landscape and format it to fit in a 40 inches TV screen

	All posters will be presented during poster walks according to the date and time arrangements in the final detailed program
	Presenting authors will be asked to participate in an open discussion, held during the poster walks, by shortly presenting/commenting the posters included in his/her group of poster walk as well as discuss on his/her own poster
	The best posters will be awarded in the closing ceremony
